




The Frog

Frogs are amphibians. Amphibians live in water when they are young but live mostly on the land when they are adults. There are four stages in the life cycle of the frog: frogspawn, tadpole, froglet and frog. The female frog lays her eggs in water. The eggs are clear and jelly-like. This is called frogspawn. The eggs hatch into tiny tadpoles that have gills to help them breathe and a tail to help them swim. The tadpoles grow two back legs and then they grow two front legs. Now they look like a frog with a tail. This is called a froglet. The froglet continues to grow and eventually its tail disappears. It is then an adult frog.
