Singular means one thing. Plural means more than one thing.

Adding 's' to most words makes a plural.

Examples: boy > boys, dragon > dragons Add 'es' if the word ends in 's', 'x', 'ch' or 'sh'.

Examples: dress > dresses, bush > bushes
