- 2. Choose a new poem topic. Examples:
 - People (babies, teachers, friends, sportspeople)
 - Nature (sun, sky, sea, moon, trees, flowers, rain, clouds)
 - Animals (cats, dogs, sheep, lions)
 - · A topic of your choice
- 3. Use a word web to think of ideas for your poem.
- 4. Write two verses of your poem.
- 5. Read your poem. Could you change any words?

- 1. Practise reading the poem. Think about:
 - · Which parts you can read loudly or quietly
 - Which parts you can read fast or slowly
 - Adding actions as you read
- Decide who will read each verse.
