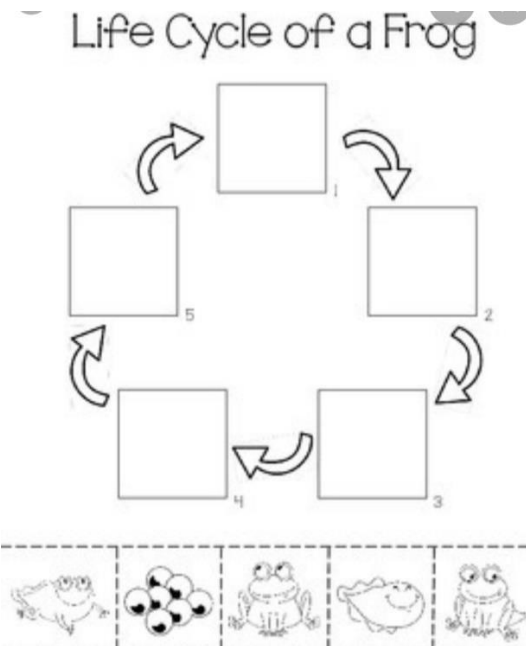
Good morning boys and girls. I hope you had fun measuring and making the sensory tray yesterday. Thank you for the photos, I loved seeing them.

## Busy Work

I am suggesting two things for busy work today. You can do one or the other or indeed *both!!*

The first activity is to make playdough!! The instructions are below with the picture. Just add some food colouring if you have some! I can't wait to see what you can create with the playdough. Be sure to send pictures! If you have a sandwich bag or plastic take-away container to keep it in, it will remain moist for re-use!!

### Playdough

Homemade playdough: Cup of flour, half a cup of salt, water and some oil!



The second suggestion for today is to make a *paper plate frog*!! If you don't have paper plates, just cut a circle from cardboard (cereal box). You can use green tissue paper, or green pieces of paper cut from a picture in a magazine, or paint or crayons will do too!! Cut two small white circles for the eyes and colour the black part. Draw the mouth and make a tongue to stick on!! Enjoy!
