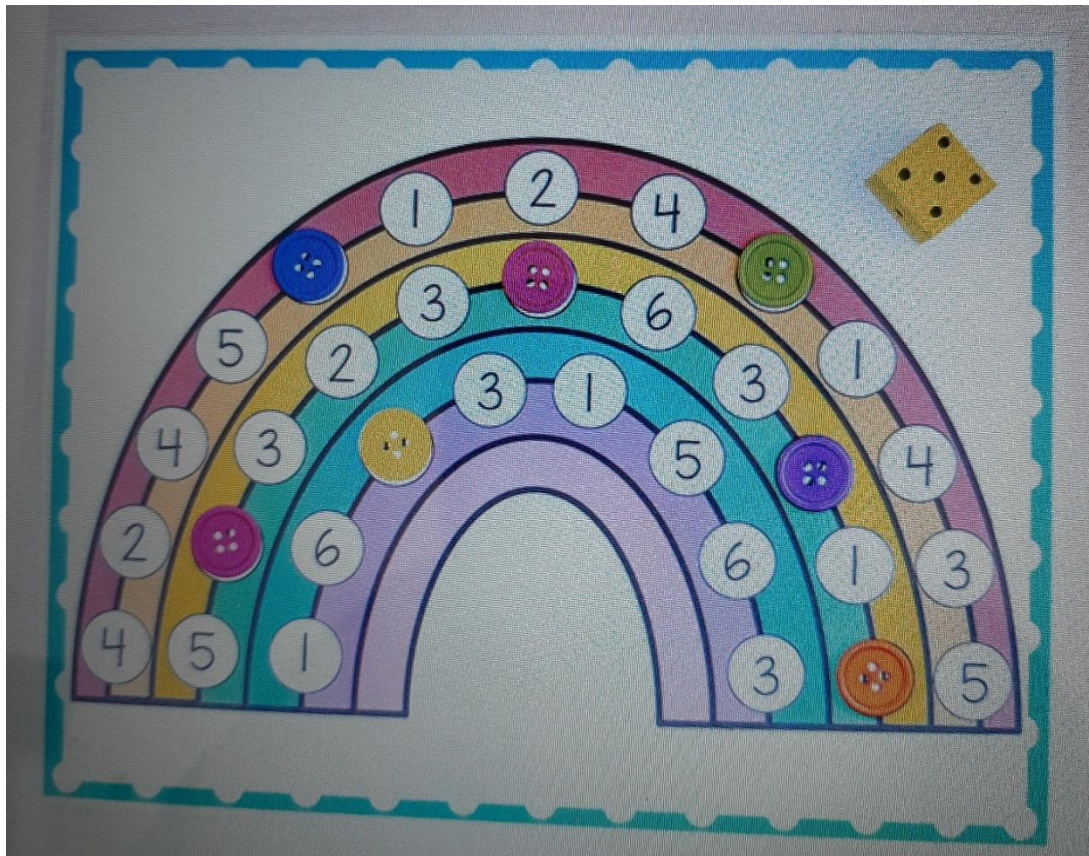
Busy Work

Rainbow Number Challenge

For Juniors use the numbers 1-6 and one dice. If you're happy they know those numbers confidently then go to number 12 for the game!

1. First draw a big rainbow and colour it very carefully.
2. Then you need to trace lots of circles (the size of 2 Euro) and cut them out.
3. Write the numbers 1-12 on all the circles, like the sample below!
4. Stick all the numbers onto the rainbow.
5. Find a dice (or two if possible)
6. Throw the dice and find the number on your rainbow.

7. Cover the number with something round ..a button (chocolate ones acceptable too!) or more pieces of paper.
8. If you have two die then throw them both and count up all the dots, then find the number on the rainbow.



Active Work

Today's game is *Skittles!*

You will need 6 toilet roll inserts. (*Don't worry if you don't haven't enough, full rolls will do either!*)

Decorate the rolls with lots of colours. Draw characters on them, like angry birds, Minions, etc. (*if you're using full rolls then wrap them in plain paper that the children can draw on!*)

Place three rolls in a row at the end of the hall near the front door, put two more on top and finally one on the top (pyramid like!).

You need a small ball, or sock balls, or even a ball of paper or tin foil will do!

Mark a start line for yourself, then roll the ball and see if you can knock down some or all of the skittles!!
