

Maths: Juniors




If you can't print this sheet then draw the dice face and practise writing the numbers.

Busy Work

Today I'd like you to make 'Rising Snakes'!! Check out the pictures below for guidance.





- 1. First you need some paper and a large plate to trace a circle.
 - 2. Then, starting at the edge of the circle draw a spiralling line into the centre.
 - 3. Decorate the snake with colours or paints (finger paints are fun!)
 - 4. Last of all, cut along the line from the edge to the centre. Hang it over a radiator and when the heat it on watch the snakes rise!!
