

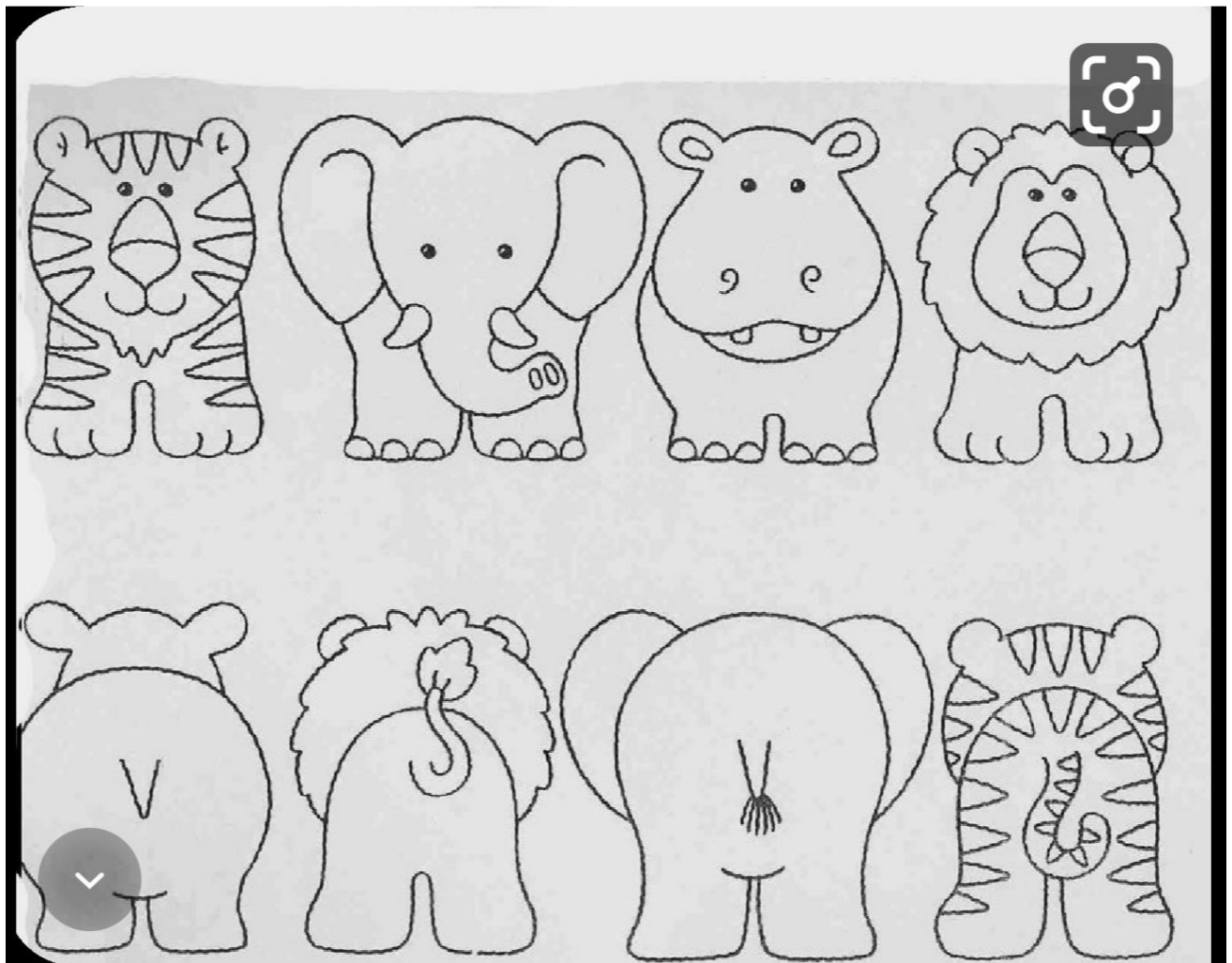

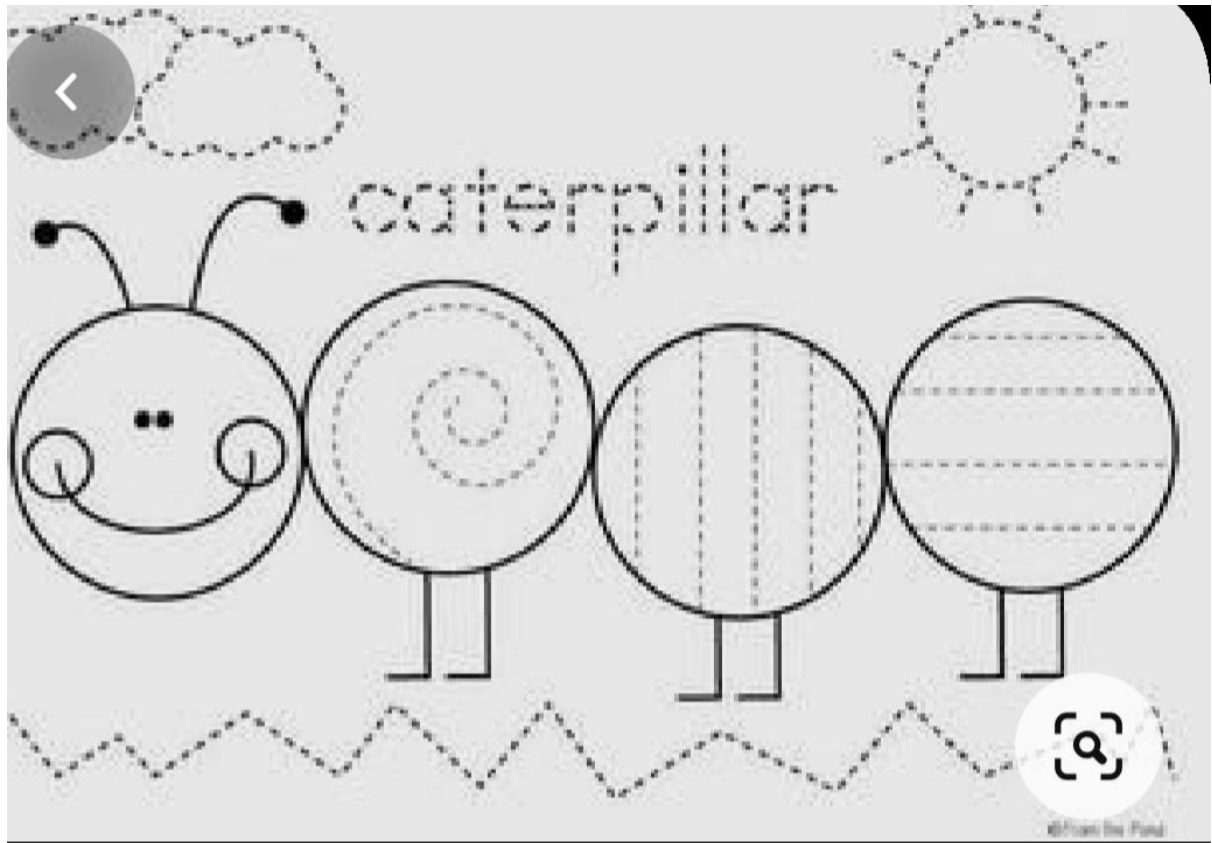
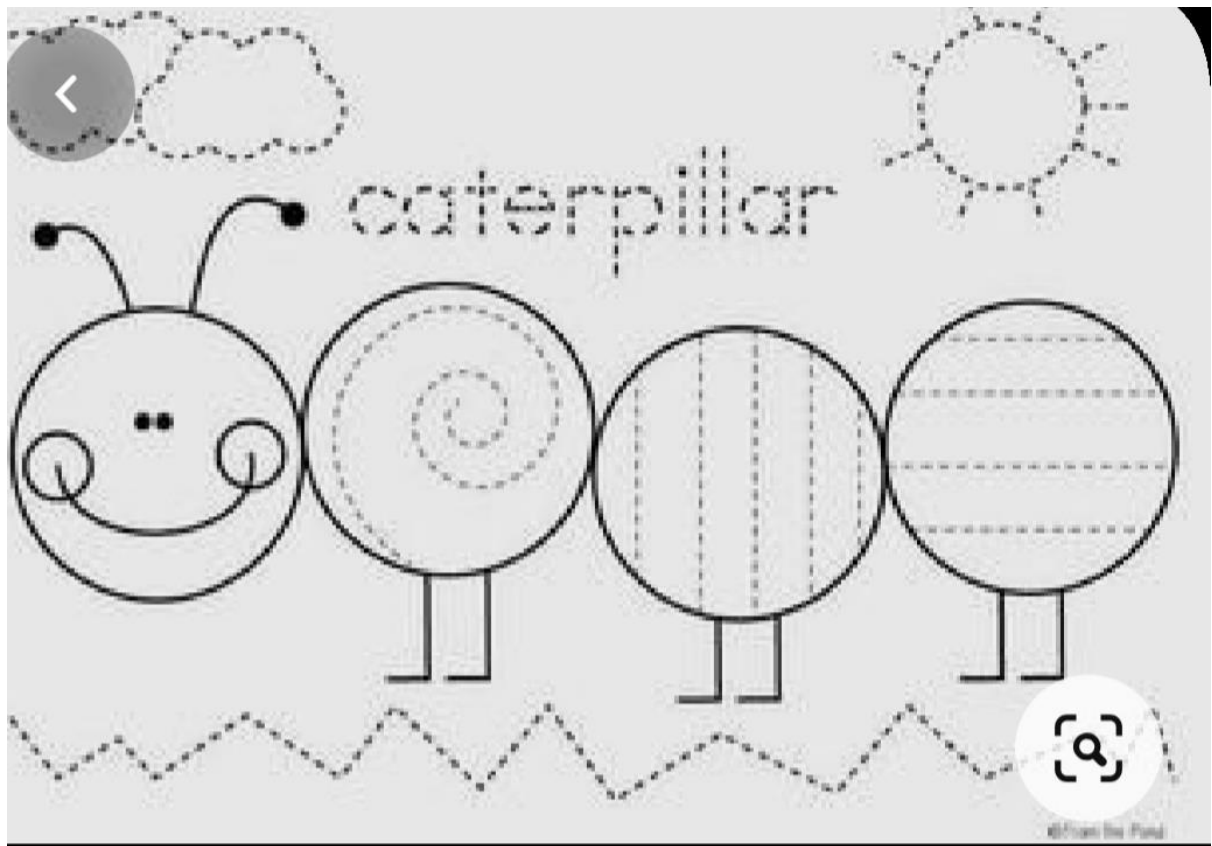
Good morning everyone! I hope you enjoyed the jungle pictures yesterday.

For the other you need to paint your hand orange and make prints with it. Or simply trace your hand, cut it out, then draw the face on your thumb and colour the tiger colours!

For the elephant you need toilet roll holders (if you have any left!) and sellotape or glue!





To Do

This activity is called 'All Swap Places'!! The idea is that each person stands holding a brush or a pole for opening Velux windows or the attic, or simply a long stick! At the count of 1,2,3 each person attempts to leave their own pole and get to the next one without letting them fall!! It should be fun!
