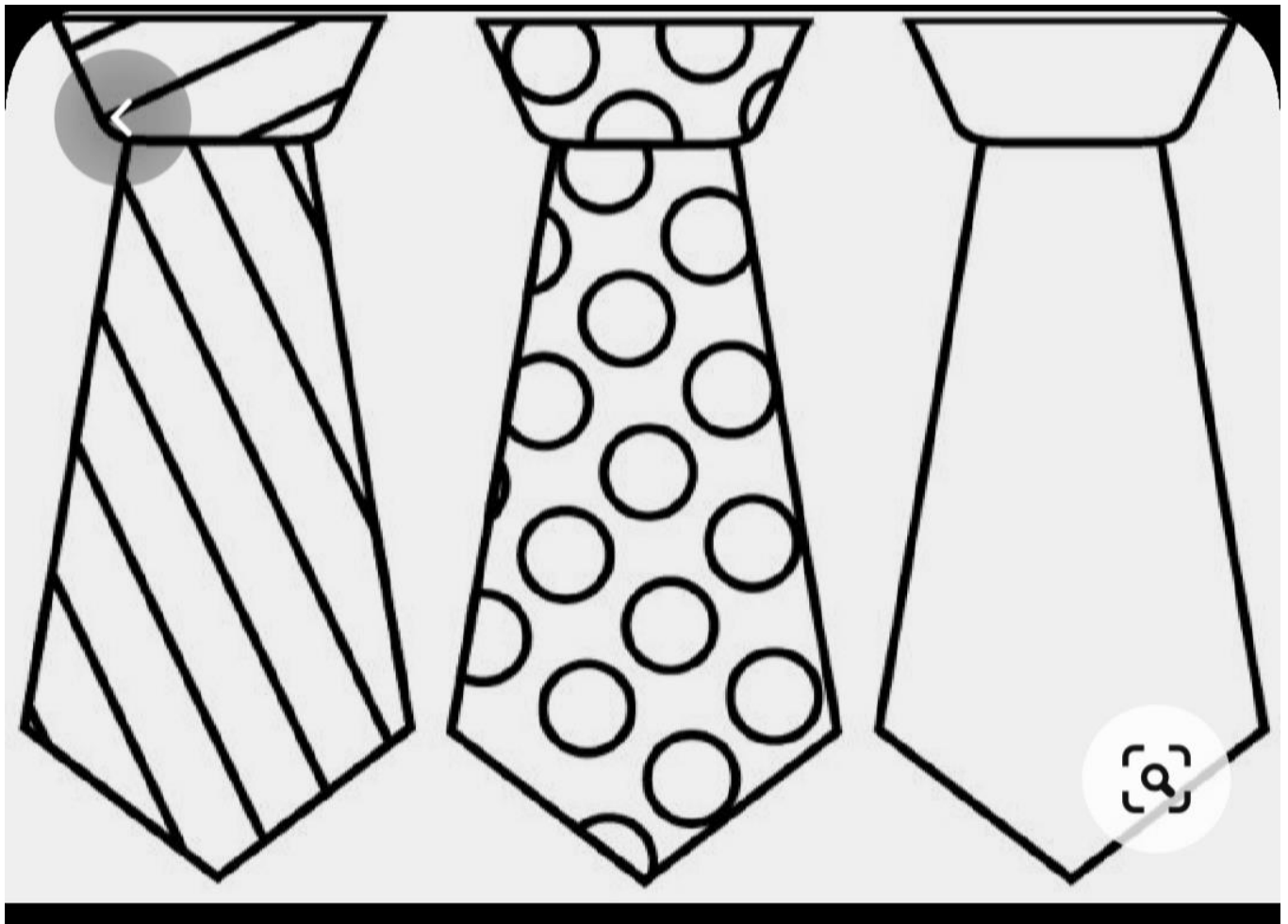


Thursday, June 18th 2020

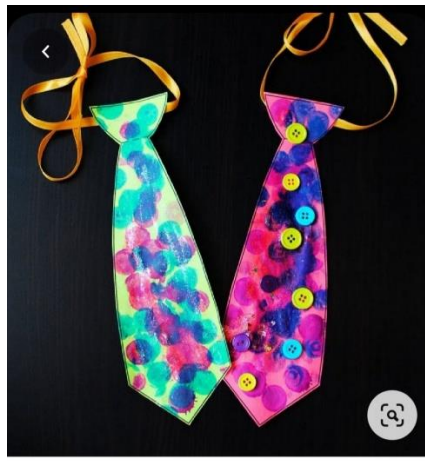

To Do

The Lego Spoon Race!!

You will need two bowls per player. A spoon and Lego (or pasta!). Put one bowl at a starting point and the other at a finish point. The idea is to pick up the Lego from the first bowl with the spoon (as much as you can get on the spoon!) and carry it to the other bowl. The winner is the person who can get all the Lego safely from the first bowl to the other one! *(If the child is playing alone, then time the operation!!)*
