Mathematical/Logical

Research the parts of a human brain and then draw a diagram of how you would imagine the parts of an android's brain would be built and wired.

Musical

Choose a section from Future Sound of London - 'Teachings from the Electronic Brain' and create a dance to it.

Intrapersonal

Think back to your earliest memories, your first day at school, when you woke up this morning and your most vivid memory. What do you remember and how does it make you feel now? Record your thoughts and feelings (in audio, video or writing).

Linguistic

Write a 'stream of consciousness' piece of writing to illustrate your conscious thoughts.

Interpersonal

In a group, discuss the statement: everyone should use their brain for thinking 100% of the day.

Naturalist

Go on a 'sensory walk' - focus on a different sense completely for two minutes. During (or at the end of) the two minutes, record your observations in a recording device.

Visual

Create a brain display with a focus on teaching a younger class. Include annotations and magnified versions of the parts of the brain.

Kinaesthetic

Construct a model of your own version of the brain, with the different parts and connections clear. Use whatever materials you feel are most appropriate.
