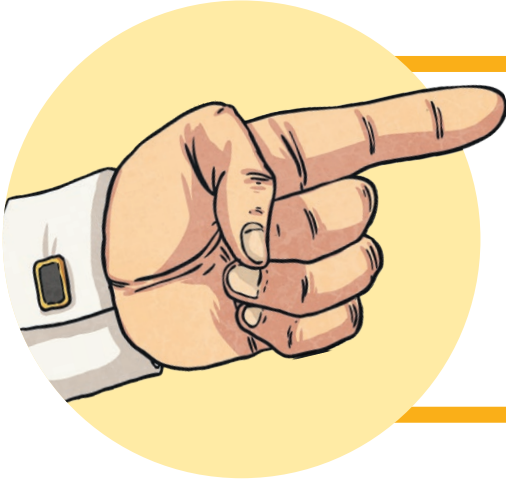


Opposites

2. Adam refused the low offer for the sale of his modern house.

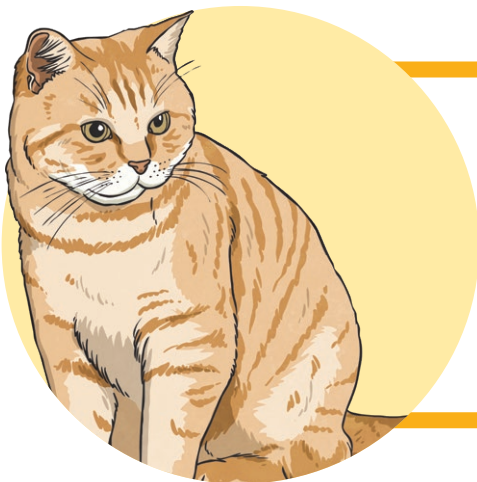


3. Sam was very mannerly and helpful towards the elderly lady.



4. The shop closure was a temporary measure, or so the local community hoped.

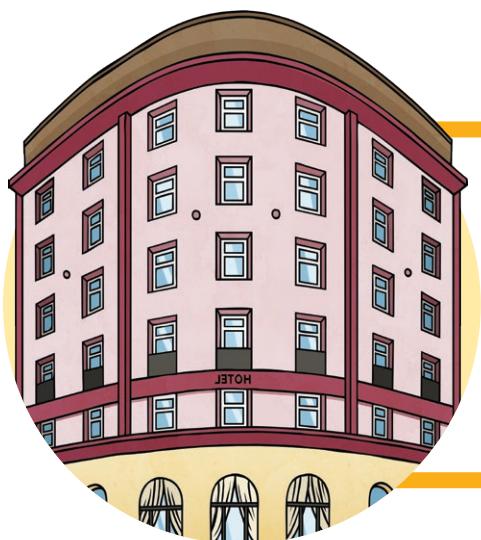
5. When the football team lost the match, the goalie felt extremely disappointed.
