



Suffixes are letters added to the ends of words.

The suffix **-s** is used to make regular plurals.

Examples: planets, trees

The suffix **-es** is used to make plurals when the word ends in s, x, ch or sh.

Examples: gases, boxes, churches, flashes

The **suffix -y** can be added to a noun (naming word) to make an adjective (describing word).

Examples: windy, dirty
